Mission: The department is committed to preparing highly qualified art professionals through a comprehensive curriculum that integrates theoretical courses—covering historical, intellectual, aesthetic, creative, and critical perspectives—with practical training in painting, drawing, and contemporary art techniques.

Objectives: The Department of Painting aims to develop skilled and innovative visual artists who can elevate the aesthetic sensibilities of society. The department also offers robust academic and research opportunities, preparing graduates to compete both locally and internationally, and to positively influence society by fostering greater appreciation for art and aesthetics.

Program Structure

The curriculum consists of core compulsory courses that establish the foundation of the specialization and fulfill the department's main objectives. These are divided into:

Specialization courses, comprising at least 56% of the total curriculum, supporting courses, representing 32%, and general courses, accounting for 12%.

This department functions as a foundational preparatory phase for art students. It provides a comprehensive curriculum of core courses that cover the fundamental principles across all art disciplines. This enables students to make an informed choice of specialization based on their skills and interests. The program also includes complementary art courses and general education requirements.
