The department first establish in 1991, under the name of interior design. The department was an independent department and did not include under the architecture department until 1999.

Vision: the department seeks to achieve excellence by providing all new knowledge from the specialization related to interior architecture, in a manner that is compatible with our local environment as well as keeping pace with global developments using modern methods by updating technical information

Mission: the department seeks to provide scientific cadres and distinguished skills in the field of interior subjects to the standards.
